Tokai Denpun Co., Ltd., started business in 1947 for the purpose of selling starch products. Since then, taking advantage of diversification in starch uses, we have handled a large number of products through our customers and business partners related to “food” in various industries and categories, explored and developed new production areas and new products both in Japan and overseas, and deployed proposal-based sales that add new features and functions as solutions to customer challenges nationwide. Today, we have domestic sales offices in nearly every prefecture, expanding our business to procurement and supply of raw materials, processing by contract manufacturing, intermediate distribution, and retail, and because we can respond with flexibility and speed to various customer needs, this advantage serves as a driving force in our further growth.

The TDC Group develops its business globally, with seven companies in Japan engaged in agricultural product processing/manufacturing (Sunny Foods, Star Agri, and Sanwa) , marine product processing/manufacturing (Tokai Seapro, Marugo Suisan, and Kushimoto Shokuhin) , and sales and distribution (Kuwamura Sanko) ,and also includes overseas raw material procurement bases in Nine countries (the U.S., China, Taiwan, Thailand, India, Vietnam, Indonesia, the Netherlands and Lithuania) , as well as internal sales bases in five countries (the U.S., China, Taiwan, Thailand, and Vietnam) , in an effort to develop cooperative manufacturing-sales relationships with Tokai Denpun Co., Ltd. In addition, the Group includes a system management company (TDC Service) and a business coaching company that develops human resources (Coach TDC) and strives to provide support both internally and externally.

In recent years, uncertainty about the future that is beyond our collective experience prevails, although the food industry overall remains unchanged. However, changes in the food industry, the way food ought to be, as well as how we access food will undergo significant changes, and I think it is important that we anticipate changes and determine business continuity while we transform our business to better respond to changing needs ahead of our competitors. 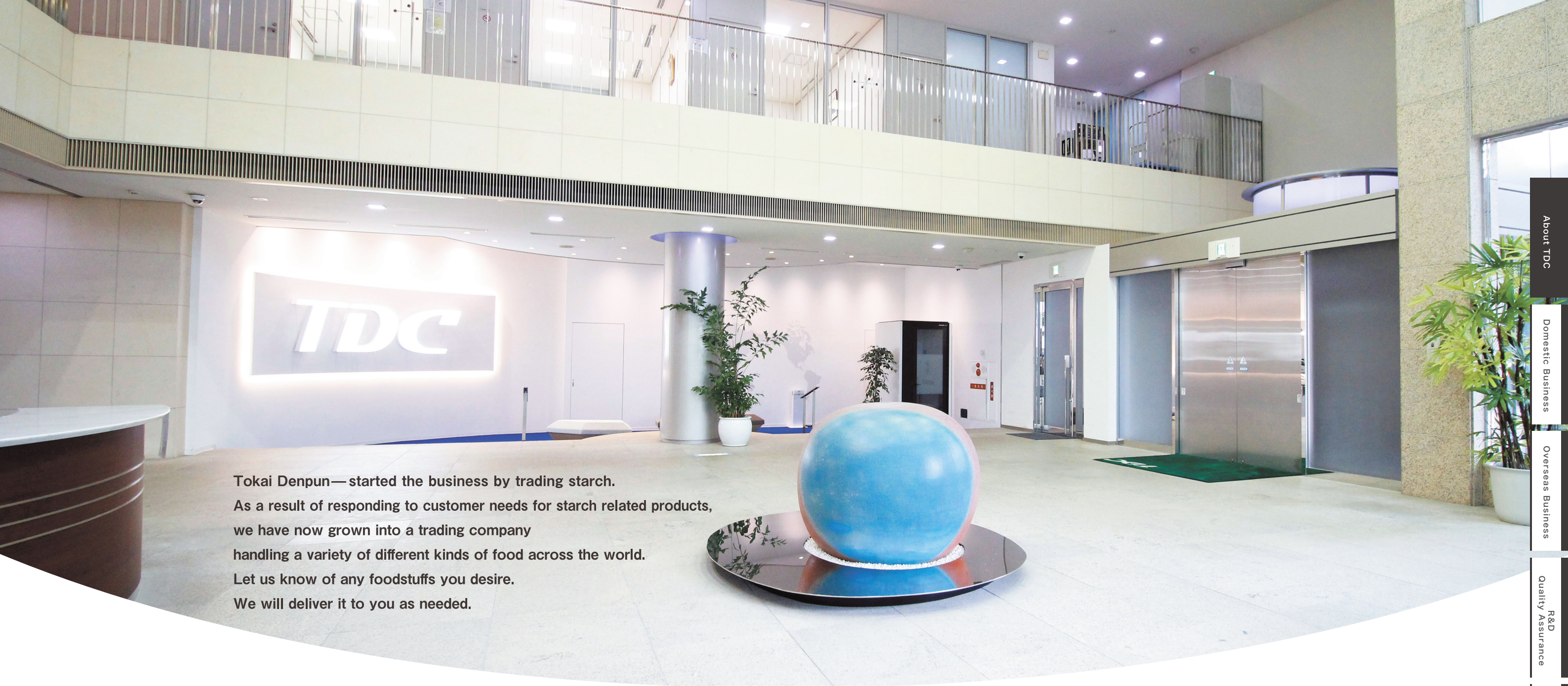

Quality Assurance

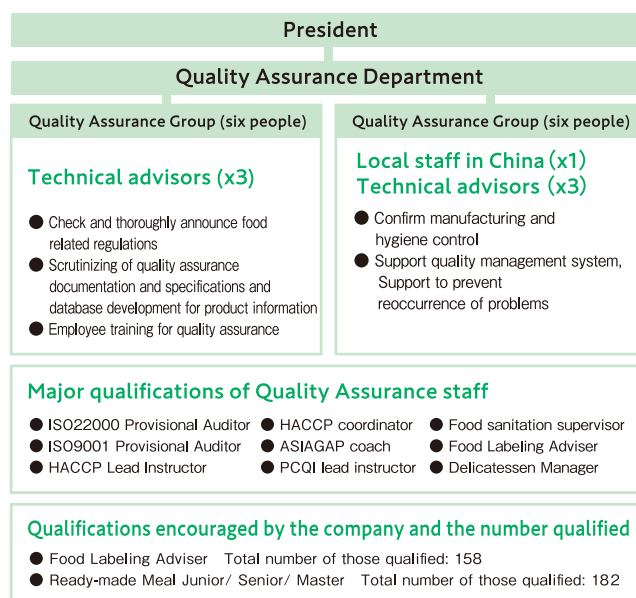
Quality assurance is the most significant issue for companies handling foods. In order to respond to increasingly demanded consumers' security and safety, TDC has the Quality Assurance Division under the direct control of the president.

Research & Development (R&D)

We face customers issues from raw materials to the final product and help solve problems.

Quality assurance system

As a company that handles foods, securing the safety of the products handled is the most important priority. We have the Quality Assurance Department in place to ensure the safety of the products handled throughout the entire Group by assigning a person in charge of quality management with quality management personnel in each office.



Overseas factory audits

The Quality Assurance Group conducts factory audits of overseas suppliers, checks operations and the management documents at manufacturing sites, and provides advice and suggestions for improvements when necessary. In cases where on-site visits are not possible, audits are conducted remotely, and our local staff and supplier's factory staff visit the production site and inform the auditor of the operational status and documentation management status, and the auditor conducts safety evaluations and offers advice and suggestions for improvements to the production site. Thus, we are working with our suppliers aiming to improve quality assurance.



Internal training

Our individual employees associated with foods are also required to have knowledge of quality control and assurance. With an aim to raise the level of quality control ability across the company, we conduct quality management training and separate study sessions for employees as a part of the activity. In addition, for employees qualified for food safety we have a subsidy program for expenses to encourage the acquisition of qualifications.

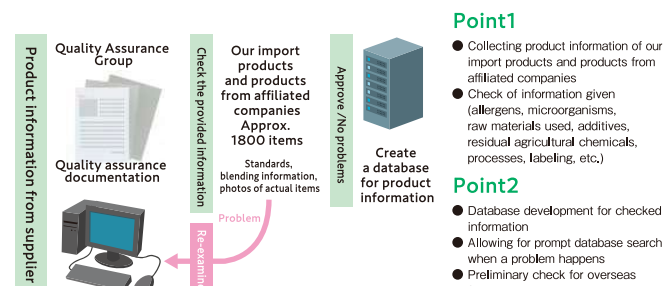

Check for product safety

The Quality Assurance Group checks information on our quality assurance documentation filled in and submitted by domestic and international suppliers. Our personnel check domestic food related regulations, the raw materials used, management standards and labels for the products, and save the product information as data to manage.

Research & development laboratory

The R&D laboratory started with the basic research and analysis of starch and has developed new processed starch. It now engages in product development, application building, and product menu development according to it based on starch features in line with customer needs as the Product Development Division of the entire Tokai Denpun Group.

Development policy

We capture market trends by utilizing the raw information obtained from information exchanges with customers, market research, and POS data and engage in product development and applications building towards the development trend obtained. Our R&D laboratory is equipped with analytical instruments to extract and clarify any issues backed up with analysis data accumulated from the past and to establish and verify hypotheses derived from the issues. It also asks customers to actually visit the lab and creates prototypes together for prompt product development.

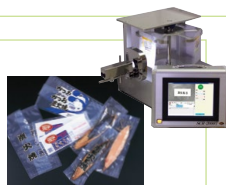

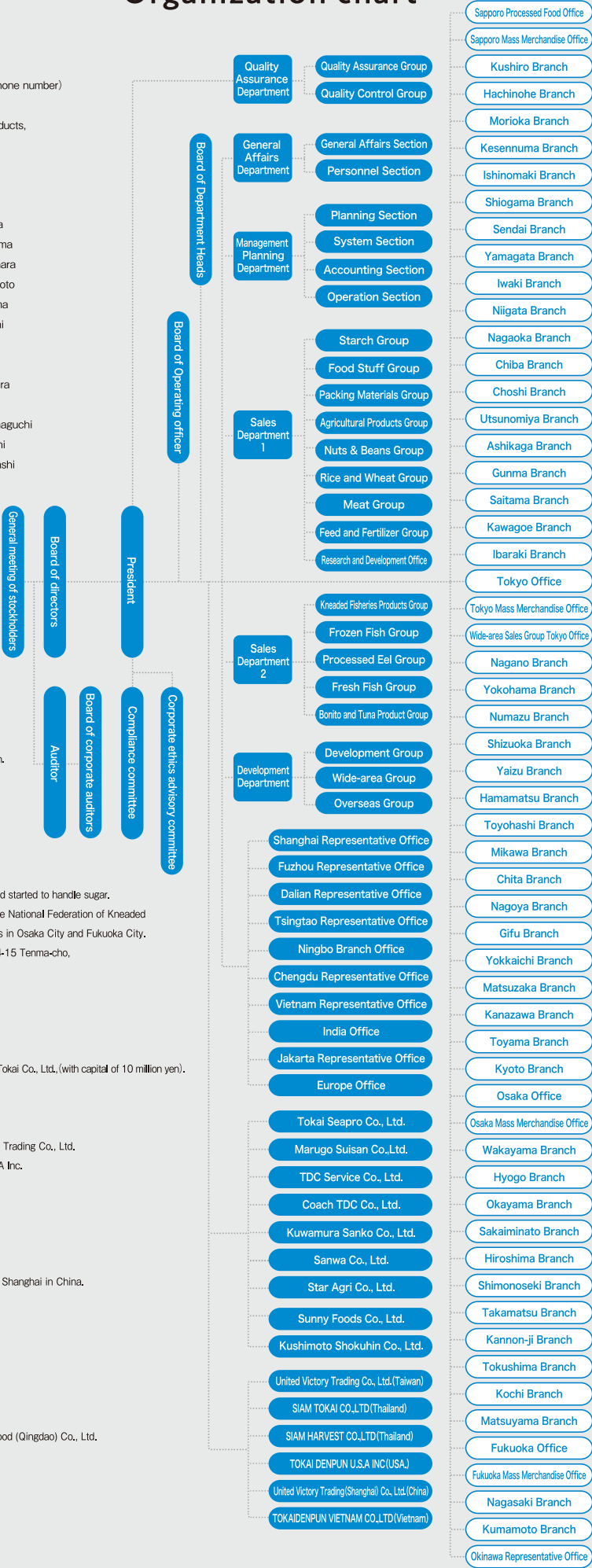

July 1946	Tokai Kagaku Kogyosho was established to process starch.
August 1947	The organization changed into a corporation, which was set up as Tokai Denpun Kogyo Co., Ltd., with its headquarters in Shizuoka City with capital of 198,000 yen. The company name changed to Tokai Denpun Co., Ltd. It became an authorized dealer of starch and condiments for Ajinomoto Co., Inc.
August 1950	Started to handle beans.
March 1951	Obtained the distribution rights to Meki (amino acid). Opened the Yaizu Branch.
July 1955	Became an authorized dealer for Nihon Shokuhin Kako Co., Ltd. and started to handle cornstarch.
July 1958	Became a wholesaler for Taiyo Fisheries Ltd. (Ensuiko Sugar Refining Co., Ltd.) and started to handle sugar.
March 1966	Started to handle kneaded fisheries products by supplying materials on behalf of the National Federation of Kneaded Fisheries Products Cooperatives (commonly known as Zenkama). Opened branches in Osaka City and Fukuoka City.
March 1968	Moved the headquarters from Hontori in Shizuoka City to the current location of 24-15 Tenma-cho, Aoi-ku, Shizuoka-shi after constructing a new building.
